Dear Neighbour,

We are writing to provide you with details of a temporary footpath arrangement between Echline Farmhouse access and the east end of Echline Farm Cottages access.

As can be seen from the attached (Google Map) sketch the footpath will be temporarily diverted to the south side of the newly excavated area adjacent to the temporarily realigned A904.

This arrangement will be in place for approximately one week, the works anticipated to commence this week. The temporary footpath surface will be of compacted stone or road planings construction which will be maintained to ensure it is safe and fit for purpose.

Footway diversion signs will be erected at each end of the temporary footpath. The pink line on the attached sketch denotes temporary fencing to separate pedestrians from our works.

As and when it is necessary for our machinery to cross the footpaths in order to gain access to the works areas, this will be under the supervision of banksmen.

Again, we would like to take this opportunity to apologise for any inconvenience our activities may cause and also to thank you for your patience and consideration to date.
