ROAD TRAFFIC

The A82 Trunk Road (Dumbarton) (40mph Speed Limit) Variation Order 2013

Made - - - - 2nd October 2013

Coming into force - - 14th October 2013

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 84(1)(a), 124(1)(d) of, and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 84(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, Scottish Ministers have given public notice of their intention to make the following Order, and have complied with Parts II and III of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A82 Trunk Road (Dumbarton) (40mph Speed Limit) Variation Order 2013 and comes into force on 14th October 2013.

Restriction of speed

2. No person may drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Variation of The Trunk Roads (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (Dunbartonshire) (Consolidation) Order 1974

3. The Trunk Roads (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (Dunbartonshire) (Consolidation) Order 1974(c) is varied so as to omit paragraph 3 of the Schedule.

4. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

- 1. That length of the westbound carriageway of the A82 Dalnottar Inverness Trunk Road, from a point 400 metres or thereby east of the eastern junction with Milton Brae, Milton, westwards to a point 120 metres or thereby west of Lomondgate Roundabout, a distance of 4420 metres or thereby.
- 2. That length of the eastbound carriageway of the A82 Dalnottar Inverness Trunk Road, from a point 120 metres or thereby west of Lomondgate Roundabout eastwards to a point 400 metres or thereby east of the eastern junction with Milton Brae, Milton, a distance of 4420 metres or thereby.
