ROAD TRAFFIC

THE TRUNK ROADS (RESTRICTED ROADS) (ULLAPOOL) ORDER 1980

Made 25th September 1980

Coming into Operation 30th September 1980

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 72(3), 73(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1973(b), the Secretary of State hereby directs as follows:-

- 1. This order may be cited as The Trunk Roads (Restricted Roads) (Ullapool) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 30th September 1980.
- 2. The length of road specified in the Schedule to this order shall become a restricted road for the purposes of section 71(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 (which imposes a speed limit of 30 mph on a restricted road).

That length of the Dingwall-Ullapool Trunk Road (A835) at Ullapool in the Highland Region from a point on Garve Road 165 metres or thereby east of the west kerbline of Mill Street southeastwards for a distance of 435 metres or thereby.
