ROAD TRAFFIC

The Trunk Roads (Restricted Roads) (Scrabster) Order 1982

Made 28th April 1982

Coming into Operation 17th May 1982

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 72(3), 73(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of The Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1973(b), the Secretary of State hereby directs as follows:-

1. This order may be cited as The Trunk Roads (Restricted Roads) (Scrabster) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 17th May 1982.
2. The length of road specified in the Schedule to this order shall become a restricted road for the purposes of section 71(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 (which imposes a speed limit of 30 mph on a restricted road).

SCHEDULE

That length of the Wick-Scrabster Trunk Road (Route A882) at Scrabster in the Highland Region from a point 142 metres or thereby south-west and thereafter south on the said road from the centre line of the access to the BP Oil Depot to a point 276 metres or thereby north east of the said centre line, a distance of 418 metres or thereby.
