#### **ROAD TRAFFIC**

The A82 Trunk Road (Drumnadrochit & Lewiston) (30mph and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2006

> Made Coming into force

19<sup>th</sup> December 2006

5<sup>th</sup> January 2007

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) as read with section 124(1)(d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b), hereby make the following Order:

#### Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the A82 Trunk Road (Drumnadrochit & Lewiston) (30mph and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2006 and shall come into force on 5th January 2007.

### Restriction of speed

- No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30mph on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order.
- No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph on the length of road specified in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order.

## SCHEDULE

### PART 1

### 30MPH SPEED RESTRICTION

That length of the A82 Dalnottar - Inverness Trunk Road at Drumnadrochit from a point 180 metres or thereby east of the extended east gable of the Visitor Centre, Drumnadrochit Hotel westwards, then southwards, then southwestwards, to a point 55 metres or thereby southeast of the extended centreline of Balmacaan Road, Drumnadrochit, a distance of 1260 metres or thereby.

### PART 2

## 40MPH SPEED RESTRICTION

That length of the A82 Dalnottar - Inverness Trunk Road at Drumnadrochit from a point 55 metres or thereby southeast of the extended centreline of Balmacaan Road, Drumnadrochit, eastsoutheastwards, then northeastwards to a point 215 metres or thereby northeast of the extended southeast gable of Borlum Bridge Cottage, a distance of 605 metres or thereby.
