### ROAD TRAFFIC

The M9/A90/M90 Trunk Road (Easter Hatton Link) (Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2012

 Made
 1st March 2012

 Coming into force
 15th March 2012

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1), 2(1) and 2(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 1(1)(a) of that Act, they consider it expedient to do so for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.

#### Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the M9/A90/M90 Trunk Road (Easter Hatton Link) (Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2012 and comes into force on 15<sup>th</sup> March 2012.

#### Prohibition of use of vehicles

2. No person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule so as to make any turn specified in Part 2 of the Schedule.

### **Exemptions**

- 3. This Order does not apply to anything done with the permission or under the direction of a police constable in uniform.
- **4.** This Order does not apply to any vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes.

## PART 1

That length of the M9/A90/M90 Edinburgh - Fraserburgh Trunk Road from its junction with the access road leading to the Easter Hatton Landfill Site, Balmedie, Aberdeenshire, to its junction with the access road leading to Millden, Balmedie, Aberdeenshire, a distance of 240 metres or thereby.
