ROAD TRAFFIC

The Trunk Roads (Restricted Roads) (Peeblesshire) Order 1975

Made	6 th May	1975
Coming into operation	14 th May	1975

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 72(3) and 73(1)(a) and (2) and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967(a) as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1973(c), the Secretary of State hereby directs as follows:-

1. This order may be cited as the Trunk Roads (Restricted Roads) (Peeblesshire) Order 1975 and shall come into operation on 14th May 1975.
2. The Interpretation Act 1989(d) shall apply for the interpretation of this order and the orders hereby revoked as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. The County Council of Peebles (Built Up Areas) Order 1935, in so far as it relates to the Edinburgh-West of Piggart Trunk Road (Route A702) and the Trunk Roads (Restricted Roads, Scotland) (No 1) Order 1966(e) are hereby revoked.
4. At 11.59 pm on 14th May 1975 each of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this order shall cease to be a restricted road for the purpose of section 71(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended (which imposes a speed limit of 30 m.p.h. on a restricted road).
5. At 00.01 am on 15th May 1975 each of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this order shall become a restricted road for the purpose of section 71(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended (which imposes a speed limit of 30 m.p.h. on a restricted road).

SCHEDULE

1. That length of the Edinburgh-West of Biggar Trunk Road (Route A702) at Carlops Village, in the County of Peebles, from the County Boundary to a point opposite the south boundary of the Manse, a distance of 695 yards or thereby.
2. That length of the Edinburgh-West of Biggar Trunk Road (Route A702) at West Linton in the County of Peebles from a point 673 yards or thereby north-east of the north junction with Route B7059 to a point 202 yards or thereby south-west of the junction with Chapel Brae, a distance of 1232 yards or thereby.
