ROAD TRAFFIC

The A86 Trunk Road (Newtonmore) (20mph and 30mph Speed Limits) Order 202[]

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 84(1)(a) and 124(1)(d) of, and paragraph 27 of schedule 9 of, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with sections 83(1) and 84(2)(b) of that Act, they have given public notice of their intention to make the following Order, and have complied with Parts II and III of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(c).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A86 Trunk Road (Newtonmore) (20mph and 30mph Speed Limits) Order 202[] and comes into force on << >>.

Speed limits

2. No person may drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding—
- (a) 20 miles per hour on the length of roads specified in Part 1 of the schedule,
 - (b) 30 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Part 2 of the schedule,

Revocation

3. The following are revoked—
- (a) The A86 Trunk Road (Newtonmore) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2002(d).
 - (b) The A86 Trunk Road (Newtonmore) (30mph Speed Limit) Variation and Newtonmore Primary School (Part-time 20mph Speed Limit) Order 2006(e).

Exemption

4. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to—

- (a) vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011^(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations; or
- (b) vehicles being used in an emergency for coastguard purposes.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

SPECIFIED LENGTHS OF ROAD

PART 1

1. That length of the A86 Spean Bridge - Kingussie Trunk Road at Newtonmore, from a point 46 metres or thereby west of the extended centre line of its junction with Strone Road to a point 18 metres or thereby west of the extended centre line of its junction with the U5523 Loch Na Leona Road, a distance of 1.247 kilometres or thereby.

PART 2

2. That length of the A86 Spean Bridge – Kingussie Trunk Road at Newtonmore, from a point 46 metres or thereby west of the extended centre line of its junction with Strone Road to a point 532 metres or thereby northeast of the extended centre line of its junction with Strone Road, a distance of 578 metres or thereby.

3. That length of the A86 Spean Bridge – Kingussie Trunk Road at Newtonmore, from a point 250 metres or thereby southwest of the extended centre line of Station Road north-eastwards to a point 18 metres or thereby west of the extended centre line of its junction with the U5523 Loch Na Leona Road, a distance of 432 metres or thereby.
